Each pdf-formatted nomination packet must include the following documents in order:

1. Nomination cover sheet
2. Department Chair's letter of submission
3. Faculty mentor's (or mentors') cover letter
4. One or two seconding letters.
5. Research abstract: Up to 350 words stating the nominee's research question(s), his/her approach or method to address the questions, the achievements/discoveries he/she has made, and the significance of the work to the field and/or society.
6. Research citation: A three-to-five sentence synopsis of the postdoctoral scholar's research achievements, written for a general audience, to be in the digital version of the program.
7. Nominee's resume or CV, highlighting publications and other professional achievements while a postdoctoral scholar at UCLA.
8. Publications: A maximum of 2 publications or articles in-press (accepted manuscripts) and 2 press releases may be appended to the nomination.
9. Photo: A recent photo of the nominee. The digital image should be a separate attachment, not part of the PDF file (headshot, high resolution, JPG, 300 DPI min.).

NOTE: Each department may select up to two (2) nominations to forward to the Graduate Division for consideration by the Award Selection Committee. Large departments or institutes with 35 or more scholars may nominate up to 3, and those with 60 or more scholars may nominate up to 4.
